Proposals should focus on institutional efforts and projects that help students succeed as well as examples of efforts that have come up short of expectations and how adjustments were made. Proposals will be reviewed with attention placed specifically on interventions supported by evidence. We are all eager to learn from past successes and struggles with pedagogy, activities, technology, and programming to improve student outcomes across all UNC constituent institutions.

Proposals will be evaluated on their demonstrated adherence to conference goals as well as inclusion of accessible, demonstrable data and information assessing the effectiveness of the program, intervention, or technology being presented. Interactivity of sessions is encouraged. If several related proposals are received, conference organizers may suggest session collaboration or a panel discussion.

Please submit a 1-2 paragraph (no more than 1,000 words) description of your proposed session. A proposal may include an *optional* upload of a PowerPoint, Word, PDF or other attachment that further showcases or explains the content of the proposed session using the following form:

Proposals must be submitted by 5pm on Friday, August 10, 2018.

Those whose proposals are selected will be notified by Friday, August 17.
